<PhD Thesis Proposal Standards>

- 1. Doctoral students must have their PhD thesis proposal evaluated by the semester immediately before defending their doctoral thesis. (The oral examination for PhD thesis cannot be held within the same semester after the PhD thesis proposal is evaluated)
- 2. If the PhD thesis proposal does not pass the evaluation, the student is given another opportunity until the semester following the presentation.
- 3. The content of the PhD thesis proposal and the composition of the judges are as follows:
 - A. The content of the proposal must be based on the thesis plan, presenting knowledge in the proposer's major, literature survey, originality of the thesis, important ideas, and specific research methods and plans.
 - B. The date of the proposal presentation should be discussed with the adviser.
 - C. The proposal presentation materials must be submitted to the individual judges at least one week before the evaluation.
 - D. A PhD thesis proposal must be evaluated by a panel of at least three judges.
 - E. At least three judges must attend the proposal evaluation, and the chairperson of the judges must create a presentation result report based on the evaluation results of each judge and submit it to the Faculty Office with the signatures of all judges. (If there are any judges who are unable to attend the evaluation due to compelling circumstances, the summary of the evaluation will be reflected after a written evaluation.)
- * This standard is applied from the second semester of 2021, in principle, and may be applied retrospectively.
